Drum circles empower individuals to reap the benefits of engaging, transformative events regardless of musical ability or experience; dissolving barriers of race, culture, gender or age.

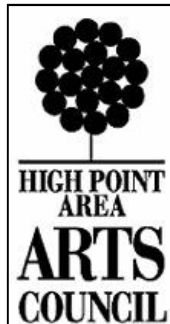
