HIGH POINT ART COUNCIL


This is the High Point Art Council's building. We are going to see the Snowy Day at the High Point Art Council's theater.



PARKING

When we arrive we will park at the designated parking spaces and walk through the front door of the High Point Art Council's building.





ENTERING THE BUILDING

This is the High Point Art

Council's main entrance. We

will use the stairs or ramp, and
go through the main door to

find the lobby.



LOBBY

This is the High Point Art Council's lobby. In the lobby, we find the box office.



BOX OFFICE

This is the box office window, where we will get the ticket. If we need to purchase our tickets we can do that here.

If you have already bought a ticket, you will give your name to the person working at the window so they can give you your ticket.

If you have a mobile ticket you can skip the box office and show it to the usher at the theater doors.



THEATER ENTRANCE

At the back left side of the lobby, we can find the theater doors, where an usher will be waiting to collect the ticket.



USHER

The usher will be wearing a name tag and a hat. You can give the usher your ticket.

If you need a program the usher can provide information about the show.



THEATER SEATING

When our ticket gets collected, we go inside the theater and find a seat.

There are no assigned seats. For this show, we will all sit in a big circle.

One of the volunteers or actors will help you find a comfortable spot.



STROLLERS

If you came with a stroller you will be able to park it at the back of the theaters.

Point A signals the entrance of the theater, point B signals the area designated for stroller parking.



CONCESSION STAND

At the right corner of the theater, there is a concessions stand where we can buy beverages and snacks.

If you have a food preference or allergies, for this performances you are allowed to bring outside food.



WHEN THE SHOW STARTS...

When the show starts, we can expect the lights to dimmer...

Note that it's okay to make noise and to move around.



MOVEMENT SPACE

On the right of the theater, behind the long curtains, there will be space for movement.

It's okay if our body needs to move during the performance, this is a safe space for that.



BATHROOMS

At the right and left back corners of the lobby, we will find the bathrooms.

There will be changing tables in both the women's and men's bathrooms.



QUIET AREA

At the lobby we find a quiet area, where we can go and relax when necessary.

In the quiet area, there will be soft chairs, noise-cancelling headphones, and fidget toys.



WHEN THE SHOW ENDS...

When the show ends we can sign clapping to show appreciation.

We can make the sign for clapping to reduce the amount of noise, for the friends around us.



WHEN THE SHOW ENDS...

Once the show ends, we exit the building the same way we enter.

We go through the theater doors and take a right turn where we will find the front doors that lead to the parking area.

If you feel comfortable, your parents can help you fill out a form that will give us a better insight on how to organize future events.
